

# **Local Rules**

These Local Rules take precedence over the ones printed on the scorecard!

#### 1 BOUNDARIES

- (a) Boundaries are defined by white stakes or lines as well as by fences with white posts.
- (b) A ball coming to rest on or beyond the road between holes nos. 4, 5 & 8 is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes, except when playing the 5<sup>th</sup> hole.

#### 2 PENALTY AREAS

- (a) Where not otherwise defined by stakes or lines the edge of the penalty areas behind the 5<sup>th</sup> and in front of the 14<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> putting green is defined by the edge of the stone blocks on the side of the general area (i.e. the stone blocks are in the penalty area).
- (b) The ponds in front of the 7<sup>th</sup> putting green are treated as a <u>single</u> penalty area.
- (c) The ponds separated by a dam on the 9<sup>th</sup> hole are treated as a <u>single</u> penalty area.

### 3 DROPPING ZONES (HOLES NOS. 2 & 5)

- a) 2nd & 5th hole: If a ball is in the penalty area, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
  - (i) take relief under R17.1, or
  - (ii) as an extra option on the 2<sup>nd</sup> hole, drop the original ball or another ball within the mat delimiting the dropping zone. The dropping zone is a relief area under R14.3.
  - (iii) as an extra option on the 5th hole, drop the original ball or another ball within one club-length from the DZ marking which is nearest to the spot where the ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area. The dropping zone is a relief area under R14.3.
- b) 17<sup>th</sup> hole: refer to 6(d).

### 4 PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

The young trees identified by stakes or guy wires are no play zones.

If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course <u>other</u> than in a <u>penalty area</u> and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under R16.1f.

If the ball lies <u>in a penalty area</u> and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty outside the penalty area (R17.1e) or free relief within the penalty area (R17.1e(2)).

#### 5 POWER LINES

If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a wire of a power line, the stroke does not count. The player **must** play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (R14.6). If the player replays the stroke but does so from a wrong place, they are in breach of this local rule. If the player does not replay the stroke, they get the **general penalty** and the stroke counts, but the player has not played from a wrong place.

# 6 ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS & INTEGRAL OBJECTS

- (a) Ground under repair ("GUR") is defined by blue stakes and/or blue lines.
- (b) Stone blocks surrounding the teeing areas as well as alongside the walkways on the 1<sup>st</sup> hole and behind the 4<sup>th</sup> putting green are immovable obstructions.
- (c) Ground under repair according to 6(a) or stone blocks according to 6(b) above and the artificially surfaced walkways they immediately tie into are treated as a <u>single</u> immovable obstruction when taking relief under R16.1.
- (d) The stone blocks on the left-hand side of the 17<sup>th</sup> hole and the protective mesh attached to them are treated as a <u>single</u> immovable obstruction when taking <u>free relief</u> under R16.1. Alternatively, the player may declare the <u>ball</u> <u>unplayable</u> and under penalty of one stroke
  - (i) proceed under R19.2, or
  - (ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball within one club-length of the DZ marking. The dropping zone is a relief area under R14.3.
- (e) Wooden lips of bunkers and man-made heaps of stones in the area of holes nos. 5-8 are integral objects (no free relief under R16.1)

## 7 CODE OF CONDUCT

Entering agricultural areas beyond the boundaries at holes nos. 1, 6, 7 und 8 (identified by white stakes with black ferrules) is prohibited. In the event of repeated non-compliance, the committee may ban the player in addition to the general penalty.

Penalty for playing ball from a *wrong place* in breach of a local rule: GENERAL PENALTY under R14.7a.
